Introduction

This index to the *Australian Book Review* has been produced by the Footscray Institute of Technology Library at the request of the Australian Book Review Editor.

This edition covers issues 48-57 for the period from February 1983 - January 1984. The first index for issues 1 to 10 was published in the *Australian Book Review* issue 12, July 1979. The index for issues 11-37 June 1979 - December 1981 and the index for issues 38-47 1982 were published separately from Footscray Institute of Technology Library.

Books reviewed are listed alphabetically in separate author and title sequence.

The author entry gives the name of the author(s) and full title of the book. The reference is to the issue and page number, followed by the name of the reviewer.

The title entry gives abbreviated title, except in the case of books without authors which are indexed by title in full. The reference is to the issue and page where the book is reviewed.

There is a separate alphabetical index to reviewers with issue and page number. The reviewers of Booknotes (B.N.) are included when known.

To provide a more complete index to the *Australian Book Review* an author and title sequence of articles and regular features other than reviewers is included for the first time. This sequence also includes the titles of periodicals that have been reviewed in the articles.
